

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
### INTRODUCTION

The Office of the Controller of Examinations shall be responsible for maintaining the standard of all the University Examinations. It is the duty of the office of the Controller of Examinations to arrange for preparation, scheduling, conduct of University Examinations, arranging for valuation of answer scripts and all other incidental matters connected with the conduct of examinations.

The other responsibilities of the office are:

- a) Processing and publishing the results in time.
- b) Issuing of certificates like Statement of Grades/Marks, Consolidated Statement of Grades/Marks and Provisional Degree Certificates.
- c) Providing Transcripts and Migration Certificates.
- d) Publication of rank lists and Medallists before the conduct of Annual convocation
- e) Conduct of the Annual Convocation as and when the Chancellor directs and issue of Degree Certificates to all the qualified students of University Departments and Award Degree for the students qualified.

The examinations are scheduled in line with institutions' academic calendar. The Examination process is completely automated and it was done through SRMEAS (SRM Examinations Automated System).



### INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

### **Assessment Procedure**

Both Internal and End Semester Examinations evaluate the complete academic performance of a student.

The student's performance in each course, in general, is evaluated based on in-semester (internal) assessment and end semester examination as listed below:

The faculty in-charge will be in-charge of entering all internal test components (like Cycle Test, Model Examinations, Quiz, Surprise Test, Seminar, Assignment, Field visit, case Study) of the respective students for the course handled by him /her.

At the end of the semester, the attendance earned by each student is calculated by system, students who are having 75 % of attendance and above are eligible to appear the end semester examinations. Students who are having of 65 %-74 % of attendance are made condonation and students who are having 64 % of attendance are detained from writing end semester examinations in respective courses.

At the end of the semester, the faculty will 'submit' the marks to the Head of the department through SRMEAS system and it will be sent to COE after the approval from HOD.

The Evaluation process existing in the university is absolutely transparent and effective. The students are free to raise any deviations in the evaluation process, and are being address immediately.

The internal assessment marks for each courses are intimated to all students' viva SRMEAS student portal and parents can view the marks in parent portal which would facilitate the students to channelize his/her efforts to improvise grades.

# **Passing Marks:**

A candidate shall be declared to have passed in each paper / practical / Mini Project and Viva-voce, if he / she secures not less than 40% of marks for UG and 50 % for PG (internal assessment and the End Semester Examinations, put together), provided a minimum of 40% of marks secured in the End Semester examinations for UG and 50 % of marks secured in the End Semester examinations for PG.
