The GPA (Grade Point Average) is given for each semester. Also the CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) is given in at the end of each semester taking into account the Grades and the Credits earned by the students in the courses up to that semester (From First Semester for UG and PG).

The Final CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) is given at the end of the programme taking into account the Grades and the credit earned by the students in all the courses from First Semester for 2014, 2015, 2016 batch for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Programmes. The Overall performance of the student is indicated by the CGPA on a 10 point scale. This is approximately equivalent to CGPA multiplied by 10 on a scale of '0' to '100' marks.

% of marks Secured = CGPA Secured x 10

The Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) is calculated by considering all the courses taken from the first semester onwards for regular students and from third semester onwards for MCA-lateral entry students.
