Vocational Training

During the third semester students will go for a Vocational Training with an organization for the period of 1-2 months, where students apply their learnings in the previous semesters in a practical situation. At the end of the project, they are assessed by an internal examiner on the basis of their performance during the period by way of a report writing, viva-voice and power point presentation.

Industrial Training

During the final semester, each student will go for an Industrial Training with an organization on a project for a period of 4 months. The objective is to allow students to choose a topic/department of his/her choice in an area in which the students are comfortable or knowledgeable to explore oneself. At the end of the project, they are assessed by an internal as well as external examiner on the basis of their performance during the period by way of a report writing, viva-voice and power point presentation.

How to Reach SRM University Sikkim?

By Air

The nearest airport is Pakyong, which is at a distance of 35 km from Gangtok. This airport is connected to Kolkata and Guwahati. Another airport is Bagdogra airport near Siliguri, which is at a distance of 124 km from Gangtok. This airport is connected to Kolkata, Delhi and Guwahati International travelers can get connecting flights from Kolkata or Delhi. Both are well connected with many cities in India and abroad. Helicopter services are available from Bagdogra to Gangtok, only once during the day.

By Train

The nearest rail head is New Jalpaiguri, which is nearly 148 km from Gangtok. It is well connected to most of the major cities in India.

By Road

The roads of Gangtok are well maintained and makes for a safe drive. The highway 31A connects this place with the neighboring cities and many others too. Bus services are also available on daily basis.
